Amador Recovery offers an array of person-centered services based on a program approach of medication, counseling and support for persons in recovery. **This Recovery Project is funded by SAMHSA/CSAT for persons and families experiencing homelessness—those who lack (or at risk of losing) a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence, including persons fleeing violence or who are “doubling up” in another person’s residence on a temporary basis.** Our Recovery Project also serves persons with NM Medicaid having a chronic substance use disorder (SUD). Persons with other insurance or self-pays may be accepted into the program also. Our local team of medical and behavioral health professionals is committed to those in need, realizing that there are multiple pathways to recovery for each individual. Amador Recovery utilizes evidence-based best practices to enhance each patient’s capacity for sustained, long-term control over substance use. Our mission is to ensure that each client regains the highest levels of overall health, wellness and quality of life.
