Consulting Dentist

Overview: Part-time 8-16 hours per month. Knowledgeable about the dental care industry and advise on practice operations and procedural elements of dentistry.

The scope of activities involved in this capacity range from benefit analysis to cost-effectiveness evaluation. The dental consultant may be called upon to mediate cases where conflict or ethical issues have emerged. This may involve day-to-day operations, including staff recruitment and training, and collection protocols to reduce open receivables. It may also extend to implementing marketing strategies targeted toward increasing client base and retention. Reviews the education and history of participating staff, as well as assessing the standard of care each provides.

Major Activities and End Results:

1. Provides and oversees direct dental diagnosis, treatment, procedures, are for a specified patient population.
2. May be involved in day-to-day operations, including staff recruitment and training, responsible for overseeing correct diagnosis for collection protocols to reduce open receivables.
3. Oversee Quality Improvement programs and ensure that staff are engaging in continuous Quality Improvement.
4. Ensure providers operate in accordance with relevant regulations and best practices, and access appropriate resources.
5. Coordinate with DACC Dental Hygiene program staff and faculty, to ensure deliverables in the contract are fulfilled.
6. Responsible for ensuring provider core services evaluation provide services according to their licensure, certification, etc.
7. S/he will report directly to CEO.

- Minimum Qualifications: Experience working with under-served populations, providing primary care in a medical and clinical setting. Experience providing clinical supervision and program oversight
