Justice Involved Programs



What are Justice Involved Programs?

They are voluntary person-centered programs not ordered by the justice system for individuals involved in non-violent crimes related to their problematic use of opioids, methamphetamine or alcohol who need help with issues they are facing.

NO WRONG DOOR to treatment... hope, help, healing, happiness.



Jail Release/ Community Reentry

*When you are released and return to the community, you will be at greater risk of opioid overdose due to low tolerance.

*Before you leave, you will be given an overdose rescue kit with Narcan.

*You may also be eligible for **medication assisted treatment (MAT)** support with buprenorphine/Suboxone or naltrexone/Vivitrol.

Addiction Myths? Wrong!

1. Substance misuse is a character fault, lack of willpower, or a moral weakness
2. Prescribed medication is substituting one addiction for another
3. Abstinence is the only way to recovery

MAT Benefits? Yes!

Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) with Naltrexone/Vivitrol or Buprenorphine/Suboxone To:

- Eliminate withdrawal symptoms from not using
- Stop or reduce cravings to use
- Prevent/reduce euphoria effect (high, buzz) of using
- Normalize/stabilize brain chemistry affected by using

Follow These Steps:



WHILE IN JAIL

Consider your choices and options for a better quality of life regarding substance use. You may start your recovery journey while incarcerated.



BEFORE RELEASE

if you decide to participate in recovery services, you will sign a release of information (ROI) for/between community providers.



WHEN RELEASED

Your Amador Case Manager will work with you to create an individualized service plan (ISP) and will help you navigate and access services. Your Case Manager will aim to meet with you weekly at a convenient location in an office or out in the community. Based on your needs and goals, your Case Manager will assist you to connect with community resources, services, and support.

These may include:

- Ways to control, reduce, or stop substance use
- Arrange and accompany you for appointments
- Transportation help to/from appointments
- Medication delivery and supervised dosing
- Individual counseling and groups/classes in person or via telephone or video calls
- Adjunctive therapies such as Acudetox
- Applications for income and housing support and other public benefits
- Apply for or reactivate Medicaid
